DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house began as a two story frame house of three bays in length and one in depth with its principal a facade oriented towards the north, toward Ab Hatchet Thicket Rd. The downstairs consisted of two rooms flanking a central passageway. In recent years this has drastically been altered, with the wexterior being bricked over, the interior re-modelled to suit modern tastes, and additions attached to the gable ends and erear of the house. In short, the old house has been thoroughly modernized to suit the tastes of a contemporary farm family.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

According to local oral informant and careful historian Edwin Beitzell, this house was originally the dwelling of Tommy Thompson, a prominent landowning Negro farmer in the Abell community. It was apparently more modest in size and design than the home of his neighbor Robert Henry Collins, though Thompson was probably the larger landowner.


