DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Pasadena Inn is located in Royal Oak, Talbot County, approximately .1 mile north of Thornton Road. The owners say that an early frame house exists within the current structure, but various alterations and additions necessary for the commercial operation of the inn have concealed any traces of earlier architecture.

The present structure has an architectural appearance of an early twentieth century revival style. The main section is three and one-half stories and two by five bays. The gable end main facade faces west and has a two story portico with double columns at the front corners supporting a molded pediment. The central entrance has a small columned porch and the doorway has side lights and a transom. The second story has 6/6 sash windows and the third story has 2/2 sash windows and a single 2/2 sash window in the gable. All windows have red louvered shutters.

Flanking the main portico are one story hipped roof porches. The one on the south side continues the full length of its facade and is screened in. The rest of this facade has sash windows and there are three gabled dormers on the roof. On the north side, the facade is similarly fenestrated, and the one story porch continues in an ell shape along a north wing. The east gable end has a recent exterior brick chimney stack. The north wing has been extended for a kitchen area, and various one story additions and sheds have been added to it.

The interior is also styled in an early twentieth century manner. There is a small vestibule and staircase hall. Then there is a large double parlor with a dining room in the north wing. The interior trim is mostly late 19th and early 20th century in design.

There are some late 19th and early 20th century outbuildings of interest. Also there is an early shed with very wide clapboards.

Tourist hotels like the Pasadena Inn were ~~once~~ prominently found in many of the small villages located along the water in Talbot County. Changing attitudes and resort habits have led to the disappearance of an important feature of the architectural and social character of Royal Oak.

The Pasadena is an important survival of this phenomenon which has retained its original intent.




