

Addendum

Esperanza Point, also known as Greenholly Point, is located along the Patuxent River. It is the historic location of a nineteenth century house owned by Isaac Solomon, and later by his brother, Charles Solomon. The house was demolished in the mid-twentieth century for the development of Esperanza Farms by the Esperanza Development Corporation. Local tradition holds that the house was used for a time as the clubhouse for the subdivision, but was later demolished and a new house was built on the same site, reusing some of the brick from the nineteenth century dwelling. Since the house no longer exists and a new house is located at the same location, the property is not recommended as eligible for listing on the National Register under criteria A-C and it was not evaluated under Criterion D.
