Bearfields, a 1½ story frame house with a gambrel roof, beaded clapboard siding, and a flush chimney, to which was added a frame kitchen wing with a gable roof, was moved to its present location in 1976 from its original location in northern Queen Anne's County. The present dining room is the oldest section of the house, built in 1794 by George Primrose, and boasts a vertical beaded board paneled wall and a handsome mantel with reverse dog-ear molding. The stair hall and parlor were added circa 1820, as was the kitchen wing. Other noteworthy features include a number of period six-panel doors with large carpenter locks, and the original staircase.
