DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

It has a small frame story and a half portion with a nearly equal size two story portion, frame, covered with weatherboarding. Probably built on brick piers, the siding extends to the ground. The fenestration has been changed on the west side but it does have two dormers on the earlier part with a chimney within each end. The west is covered with asbestos siding. Also, on the west is a partially screened porch and enclosed leanto hanging out over the both sections. The two story section looks like it is late 19th century or early 20th century. In appearance, it resembles Mulberry Grove on Taylor's Island. It has two windows and a door on the first floor and three windows on the second floor of the east side and only one window on the second story west. There is also a screened porch on the east side in front of the two story section and an enclosed porch on the story and a half section. There is a brick chimney within the gable of the two story section.
