DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The "Emma B" is a house located on the property of Leonard Greenhawk at Woolford. It is a small five bay long one and one-half story frame dwelling house built on brick piers. There are two dormers on each side of the steeply pitched A roof. Some of the original beaded weather-board remains on the outside walls, as well as some of the original raised panel shutters. It is otherwise in poor condition and in danger of being lost.</p> <p>The interior is composed of a "hall", "parlor", and kitchen, the latter divided laterally by a vertical board partition. The "hall" lacks its fireplace, but retains the original stair with closet beneath. The doors to the stair and closet are raised panel, like those in Mrs. Brooks house across the road. The parlor has some vertical beaded board paneling and chimney. In the northeast corner of the kitchen is an enclosed stair to the second story.</p> <p>The second story is divided into three rooms, the kitchen chamber having an interesting and unique balustrade composed of the newel extending to the roof with a horizontal member mortised into the newel and slats running from it to the floor.</p> <p>The building has sufficient original material to be of interest for restoration.</p>
