DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The building is a frame structure four bays deep and one bay wide, with a steep pitched "A" roof, constructed on brick piers, with the exception of the north facade, which has a foundation. However, the foundation looks as though it is brick filled between the piers. On the north west corner of the building projecting both from the north and west corners is an entrance tower. The tower consists of double doors with transom above, and like all of the windows in the structure, it has a Welch arch. Above the windows of the porch tower is a open belfry with a balustrade and a short gallery repeating the design of the balustrade. Like the churches in Taylor's Island, this church has an octagonal steeple issuing out of a hipped roof. On top of the steeple is a composition of fret work holding a brass ball and arrow weather vane.</p> <p>The facade of the structure is actually the gable. In the center of the first floor are three windows, the center window being slightly taller than those flanking it. In the gable is a small square stained glass window set on the diagonal. Between the second and third bays on each side is a brick chimney which is built within the structure. The walls are covered with German siding and the cornice has fret work brackets.</p> <p>Surrounding the building is a grave yard bearing rather impressive grave stones. The entire yard is surrounded by an iron fence, and that part of the fence which borders the road has brick piers supporting a gate for the pedestrians and a gate for vehicles.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

"The first Methodist Protestant Church of Madison was organized in the school house in 1840 by Dr. D. F. Ewell and some members who withdrew from the Methodist Episcopal Church. Next they used a barn belonging to William R. Tall that had once been the Methodist Episcopal Church. In 1843 Cambridge Circuit was organized, and Tobacco Stick, Church Creek, and Lakesville formed part of the new charge. In 1860, during the pastorate of Brother W. H. Lane, the church building that had been erected at Church Creek many years before was moved to Madison and rebuilt on a more desirable site. In 1882 it became a part of the St. Paul's Church of Cambridge. In the summer of 1892 the new building was finished. In 1941 the Quarterly Conference changed the name from Madison to Gethsemane."
