DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Street Church is a 'L' plan frame building with a tower in the corner where the two sections meet. Each gable has two windows with 4/4 pane sash with weather-board below and imbricated shingle in the gable. The tower is the most impressive part of the otherwise simple structure. Its entrance is composed of double doors, with bolection molding around the panels, and a lancet arch transom above. Where the walls of the tower stop - the roof begins, there is a gable on each side. The four sides of the lower roof, covered with the same type shingle as the principal gables, taper gently inward about 2/3 the height of the tower where a pyramidal roof, wider than the portion below, extends approximately another third to the apex. A small decorative ornament crowns the apex. The upper portion of the tower seems so wide that it could use brackets to soften the break between the two sections of roof.

Street Church is an interesting religious structure and in form resembles Washington Church in the north part of the County, with the added tower. More specifically, it resembles Hooperville Methodist Church, not only in form, but in some detail of the tower. Another tower with comparable detail and proportion exists on Zion Church in Toddville.
