<p>The first old dwelling on Ross Neck is a two part frame structure with additions on the north end. The main part is one and one-half storys, with two windows flanking a center door and two dormers on each side of the 'A' roof. Only one chimney exists on this portion located between it and the lower kitchen wing. The latter portion has a pair of new casements on the first story and a dormer above. It also has a chimney.</p>
