This is a small frame commercial building of two stories. There is a pointed arched window in the gable on the front, and on the second floor are three fairly tall, round, arched windows. Although the second story remains basically unaltered, the first story has been covered by black brick or tile and large glass windows have been added.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This small store is the only frame building on this block of Race Street. It is interesting to note that before the fire of 1910, most of the buildings on Race Street were of frame construction, but they were rebuilt in brick after the fire. The pointed arched window in the gable of this structure reflects the influence of the Gothic revival style. Unfortunately, the modern store front renovation, on the first story, conflicts with the original style of the building.
