STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Built sometime around the early 20th century, this commercial building has been altered in appearance by the addition of "Form Stone" to the exterior. This side of Poplar Street survived a fire in the 1920's and most of the buildings date to the late 19th or early 20th century. The least altered buildings, however, are on the west end of the block. The potential attractiveness of the street has not been taken advantage of by owners of these buildings.


