## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Built of brown brick, this two story commercial structure bears similarities to the old Phillips Hardware Store at the corner of Race and Muir Streets, as well as to 450-452 Race Street (McCroy's) and to 444-446-448 Race Street (Western Auto and Stelens). All of these buildings employ two contrasting colors of brick, slightly recessed corbeled brick rectangles to accentuate each bay, and have pressed tin cornices. These buildings were probably designed by J. Benjamin Brown. The upper stories of this building remain unaltered, although the cornices are in need of paint. The two "storefronts" have been renovated on the first story. There are six windows across the second story, and each of these windows has a flat arch above of a dark brown stone.




