DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick building, probably constructed in the late 19th century, has undergone little change. It is a three story structure with a three bay front facade. The projecting cornice is supported by carved brackets at the corners and is ornamented by modillions. Over the windows on the second and third stories projecting flat arches are supported by brackets. There are wood slat awnings in front of the second story windows and across the street level story.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This attractive commercial structure was probably built in the late 19th century and remains relatively unaltered. Almost all of the buildings on this side of Poplar Street date to some time around the turn of the 20th century, but the least altered of these buildings are on the west corner of the street (where this building is located) from 533 to 543. These are some of the most distinctive commercial buildings in Cambridge. Other buildings on this side of the street have been altered, but could be returned to their original appearance.


