

<p style="text-align: center;">The Chestertown Pharmacy is a two-and-a-half-story building which was built in the nineteenth century. It is two bays wide and the lower two stories have recently been "Colonialized." There is a large plate glass window, a crude broken pediment above the first floor and two windows on the second floor. The facade has been faced with salmon brick. The roof has two triangular dormers with colored glass around the outside and a projection, resembling a small tower, with a pinnacle, iron fence and weathervane. The roof is mansard on the facade only.</p>
