## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The sculpture stands in the town green of Still Pond, a grassy site in the center of the town which had been vacant since the Victorian Town Hall burned about the time of the First World War. The project was conceived as an expression of the life of the small historic town. The work was funded jointly by the Kent County Arts Council and an anonymous donor.

The sculptor, Larry White, has practiced professionally in Kent County for several years. He saw this sculpture as an opportunity to explore his own thoughts about the nature of aluminum and the nature of public sculpture. He wished to communicate in a symbolic way growth and upspringing. The motifs he was studying at the time were chiefly natural and ceremonial. The ideas on which this sculpture grew out of were flowers, clouds, and banners, joined together in a rising symbol springing on a stalk or shaft coming out of the ground.

The sculpture was dedicated at a town picnic in July 1979.


