DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Partnership wing, located on Flowers Road west of Queen Anne is a small frame one-and-one-half story structure standing on a block foundation, which originally was the kitchen wing of Partnership. It was removed from the main house and moved to its present location in the 1940's when Partnership was restored and enlarged.

From a break in the German siding, the sill can be seen. It is a hewn oak member. From a similar hole in the cornice, the end joist appears to be hewn; however, none of the remaining frame is visible. The overall dimensions of the building are 27'-2" x 20'-4".

Its south facade has two doors and two windows with 6/6 sash. On the 'A' roof are two dormers with 6/6 sash. The cornice and return of the dormers has a "Gothic" molding, typical of the 1830 period. Across the facade is a cantilevered hood over a narrow porch, probably constructed in the 1940's.

The north facade has only one door and two windows and a small leanto screened porch. This side of the roof also has two dormers. Both gables have one window on each story; however, the west gable windows are off-center.





The building has two rooms on each story. In the northwest corner of the west room (kitchen) is a narrow enclosed ladder-like stair. Between the two rooms is a brick chimney, south of center.

The trim on the first story is a very plain board with bead. The doors are late 19th century 4-panel doors. The interior finish appears to be second half 19th century.
