DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Price Apostolic Church of the Living God is located at the north end of Booker Street, just east of Rabbit Hill Road on the northern edge of Price, Maryland.

This small frame temple form church is oriented on an east-west axis, with the principal gable facing west and a small rectangular apse projecting from the east gable. A one story shed roof lean-to covers the entire north facade.

The entrance is centered on the west gable wall. The double doors are flanked by a single 2/2 window on each side. A small square window in the upper gable provides ventilation to the loft. A concrete cornerstone set in the southwest pier is inscribed "Johnsons AME Church, B. Nov. 1920".

On the south facade, there is a brick stove chimney in the center flanked by 2/2 windows in the east and west bays.

There are no openings in the east gable, and only one small 2/2 window on the north and south wall of the projecting apse.

7.1 DESCRIPTION

The one story lean-to covers the entire north facade of the building. There is a door and a 6/6 window in the west wall of the lean-to, three 6/6 windows in the north wall and one 6/6 window in the east wall.

The building rests on brick piers and is covered with asphalt roll sheathing. The eaves oversail and are boxed in.

The interior of the church consists of a large sanctuary with a center aisle and flanking rows of pews. The altar is at the east end, behind a low communion rail. Three formal Eastlake chairs are arranged behind the altar in a recess formed by the apse. There is a piano to the left and a drum set and tamborine to the right. A door in the north wall opens into the lean-to along the north facade.


