St. James AME Zion Church is located on the north side of School Street. It faces south. The present structure is brick, and it was built in 1958. It was founded in 1906 by the Rev. C. M. Oliver (he also founded St. Paul AME Zion Church-Salisbury). The two Salisbury AME Zion Churches are the only "Zion" Churches extant on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. St. James is the largest "Zion" Church and has the largest congregation. It's pastor is the Rev. C. Henry Mack. He has served in this post for 25 years.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

St. James AME Zion Church was once a small wooden church. It is now a large brick edifice and is the home of the largest AME Zion church on the Eastern Shore of Maryland. It was founded in 1906 by the Rev. C.M. Oliver (who also founded St. Paul AME Zion Church - Salisbury). It is one of two AME Zion churches in Salisbury. These churches are the only "Zion" churches on the Eastern Shore (There was an AME Zion Church in St. Michaels... Trinity AME Zion, but that congregation has long been disbanded). The present pastor at St. James AME Zion is the Rev. Charles Henry Mack, D.D. He has served this congregation for 25 years.


