Holy Trinity Baptist Church stands on the corner of Delaware Ave. & Booth Street in Salisbury. It fronts on Booth Street and is built of brick. This structure was erected in 1959. Holy Trinity is the successor to the "First Colored Baptist Missionary Church of Salisbury". That church was located on Booth Street. The Church was founded in 1882 and is the oldest black Baptist congregation in Salisbury.


