It was a three-bay-long, one-and-a-half-story house with central door on each facade. On the west corner of the house is a buttress, placed there due to a fault in the wall. There is a tall chimney on each gable. The roof has collapsed and there is only the brick walls remaining. It is one of the few old brick houses in Worcester County. Its southeast facade is laid in flemish bond with glazed headers; the northeast gable is laid in English bond and the other two sides are laid in common bond.
