The East Section is two stories and attic and the west section is one-and-a-half stories. The structure is built on a brick foundation and is now covered with asbestos siding. All windows have six over six sash and narrow beaded frames. Entrance is located on the westernmost bay of the east portion and is covered by a plain hood.
