Description:

Farlow's Pharmacy is located on the north easterly corner of the intersection of N. Main and Williams Streets. Built of red brick laid in common bond, the polygonal 3-story building is stuccoed on its off-street facades. Fenestration is regular 1/1 except on the commercial level where plate glass window in metal frames have replaced the original windows. Segmental arches of a row of headers laid a top stretchers exist over all the 1/1 windows including the 3 bays of paired windows on the Main St. facade.

The building is decorated with a corbelled cornice with saw tooth pattern and bands of stretcher laid vertically edge to edge in the same saw tooth pattern. Panels of the same type exist on the secondary facade. Ventilator spaces exist above each of the third floor windows. A flat roof is concealed by the cornice.

The commercial level of the building has been remodelled through the application of a veneer of buff brick at the time the original fenestration was changed. Presently the building is in a good state of repair.


