Description:

Nellie's Beauty Salon is located on the northeast side of the intersection of Broad and Commerce Streets. The rectangular, 2-story painted concrete block building has stucco applied to the area around the plate glass windows of the main facade. Regular 2/2 windows are present on the second floor. A stepped parapet with concrete spheres on each step exists on the principal facade and conceals the gently sloping roof. A canvas awning on metal rigging is present over the commercial entrance of the first floor. A large section of the second floor east wall has been rebuilt with concrete masonry units.

To the northwest of and connected to the building a garage/barn-like structure with gabled roof is extant. It too is of block construction and has shingles in the gable ends. The building is presently vacant and falling into disrepair.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building contributes by its scale and design to the Berlin Commercial District. Rare as a detached building within the business district, it is similar proportionally to many of the core buildings. Its stepped parapet facade and pressed block construction in a building of its size make it unique among the buildings of the commercial district. Nearly isolated on its location, it makes a strong visual statement when viewed from Broad Street.


