It is constructed of brick and is painted white. Berlin has historically had a large black population. St. Paul's ME is the leading black church in Worcester County.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This handsome brick edifice stands 25' from the north side of Flower street in Berlin. It was founded in 1677 and rebuilt in 1915. It is 180' across the front facade and approx. 130' in depth. The bricks are laid in six courses with a header every seventh row. It is painted white, has a brick foundation and a slate roof. There are gables (North-South) and (East-West). The entrance tower is located in the southwest ell of the building. There are six steps (brick) up to the 2-panel double-wooded doors (modern). There are two sets of these doors (one pair faces south the other west). There are circular colored glass windows halfway up the tower with 14 panes of colored glass in each (one on all four sides). There are frontispiece cathedral stained glass windows in the south, east and west gables. These windows are 20' and each is flanked with 14' lancet stained glass windows (one on each side). The window in the south gable depicts Christ With The Children; the window in the east gable depicts Christ Ascending into heaven; the window in the west gable depicts Christ As The Good Shepherd. At the north side of the church where the choir loft is located are 3 three-foot stained glass lancet windows.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

St. Paul's ME Church is the second oldest black Methodist church in Berlin and the most prosperous. It was founded in 1877 (the present church was rebuilt in 1915). Berlin has historically had a large black population. This church is the leading black church in Worcester County.
