It reads "Born near this site January 5, 1779. His heroic exploits in Tripolitan Wars earned him his Captain's Commission in 1804. Commanded the 'United States' and appointed Commodore in War of 1812. Killed in duel at Bladensburg, Maryland, March 22, 1820."</p>
