

NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION <span style="float: right;">OPEN TO PUBLIC <u>NO</u></span>  <p style="text-align: center;">Thebaud Cottage is a one-and-a-half-story, frame structure composed of two sections. Its tall portion is three bays long with two "A" roof dormers and the other portion is two bays long with one "A" roof dormer. It is covered with white clapboard and the windows of the first story have louvered shutters painted grey-blue. The door is painted brown and is located in the larger section, closest to the wing. At each end is a brick chimney, the one on the tall part on the outside, the other within the wall. The roof is covered with wood shingles. The sash of the first story windows have nine over six panes and the ones in the dormers have six over six panes. Two small windows in the west gable have four over two panes.</p>
