Based upon the information presented to The Maryland Historical Trust, the house at 5627 George Island Landing in Stockton is not eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places, but may be a contributing resource within a National Register-eligible historic district. Further information is required to make a determination on historic district eligibility. The two-story, two-bay house was built in the first decades of this century and is a representative example of rural domestic architecture of Maryland from this period. The house has undergone significant cosmetic alterations, including, most notably, the enclosure of the front porch and the addition of asbestos shingle wall cladding. The dwelling lacks the architectural distinction necessary to qualify it for individual listing in the National Register, but is a representative example of a type of late 19th-century domestic architecture, which along with a cohesive group, may be considered a contributing building within a National Register-eligible historic district.


