The single-family dwelling at 1435 Snow Hill Road, south of Stockton in Worcester County, Maryland is not located within an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The dwelling is an large 2-1/2-story frame American Four-square, probably erected in the first decade of this century. The dwelling sits upon a low foundation and is covered with a steep hipped roof with a gabled dormer on center of the front roof slope. It is square in plan, extending two bays deep and two bays wide and defined by long and narrow 2/2 windows. The facade is covered with a front porch (altered), obscuring the side-entry door and window configuration.

The house survives in deteriorating condition and is a representative example of American four-square dwelling forms from the period. The building lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify it for listing under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.
