The property at 1536 St. Paul Road, Stockton, Worcester County is a 2½ story three bay gable front with rear ell and one story rear side addition in deteriorating condition. It is covered with a composite shingle material

It is outside the boundaries of Stockton's eligible National Register historic district. It does not meet criteria for individual listing and has no known historic associations which would give it potential for listing. It is proposed that the Worcester County Department of Economic Development demolish this structure and replace it with a modern modular ranch-style home under the county rehabilitation program.




