The property at 417 Lincoln Street in Denton, Caroline County, MD. is located outside the National Register-eligible Denton Historic District, and is not considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The property at 417 Lincoln Street consists of a single-family dwelling on a residential lot. The house is a two-story three-bay frame dwelling with a two-story ell, to which many additions have been made. The house, set upon a low brick foundation and covered with a cross-gable roof with two interior brick chimneys, dates from the mid-to late 19th century. It is representative of the domestic building of the period and lacks the architectural integrity to qualify for individual listing on the National Register under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and thus does not meet Criteria A or B.






