Located on the south side of West Church Street outside of Hebron, MD, the site is confined on the south border by the Baltimore Eastern Railroad. Consisting of approximately 2.5 acres, the site has two existing structures, a feed bin and a one story frame building. Both date from the twentieth century, the building appears to be barely fifty years old. The once agricultural setting of the buildings has been compromised by modern construction and recreational fields. In addition, without the other components of the farm complex such as a dwelling, barn etc., the site does not possess sufficient integrity of design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association to be eligible for the Register.






