Bridge No. 22029 is neither individually eligible for the National Register of Historic Places or eligible as a contributing resource in an historic district. The 28 foot long steel beam bridge built in 1933 is one of 200 extant steel beam or closely related structures in the state built prior to 1933. Twenty-two steel beam or closely related structures are extant in Wicomico County. According to information prepared by SHA, it does not have any design significance and was not associated with any important individuals or events. The bridge is not located in any known historic district.










WEST APPROACH
