Located at 5821 Olney-Laytonsville Road (Rt.108), the Edward Mayne property consists of a main dwelling with an attached three car garage, three interconnected agricultural buildings, barn and shed. According the Richard Grubb archeological report on the property, the existing dwelling and barn were constructed in the 1890s by William A. Bulger. The current property owner, Edward Mayne, purchased the parcel in 1943. In 1951, he undertook significant expansion and alteration of the existing dwelling, resulting in a modern adaptation of the Colonial Revival including a large four column portico. Few historic materials appear to remain on the interior or exterior. The agricultural buildings have also undergone sufficient alteration to reduce their historic integrity. A large transmission line built in 1956 intrudes on the rural setting. In my opinion, the property does not retain sufficient integrity in design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association to be eligible for the National Register.


