Description:

The William Tucker House is a 1½-story, 3-bay front-gable cottage on the north side of Bonifant Road in the Colesville vicinity, Montgomery County. Constructed in 1932, the building has two additions on the rear elevation; a 1-story hipped roof addition and a 1-story, front-gable addition.

The structure has an asphalt shingle roof with a central brick chimney. It is of wood frame construction with asbestos siding and it has a formed concrete foundation. The windows are 6/6 wood sash and the house has a full-width, 1-story porch on the front elevation. The porch has a hipped roof, formed concrete piers with wood columns above, a wood railing and wood lattice skirting.

There are no outbuildings associated with this building.

The property is located on the north side of Bonifant Road, with residential properties to the west and open land to the north and east. The property's setting is altered, due to modern residential development west of the property and on the south side of Bonifant Road. In addition, the property is near the intersection of Bonifant Road and New Hampshire Avenue, in the midst of a high traffic volume area.


