




Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*  
The Ike Smith Pumphouse was constructed in 1938 by the WPA to pump water from the stream to Camps 2, 3 and 4 of the new Catoctin Recreation Demonstration Area. Later, a spring collection system replaced the stream. Today, the original reservoir is fed by wells. Basically unaltered and containing much of its original pumping equipment, the pumphouse is significant as an original park structure constructed by one of the public works agencies that established Catoctin RDA. Its construction of native quartzite and wooden shingles reflects the rustic style of architecture employed through the park during this period. The pumphouse is eligible under the ECW Architecture of Catoctin Mountain Park Multiple Property nomination.
