The Webster house, located at 11276 Hodson White Rd., Dames Quarter, Somerset County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Webster House is a 2-1/2 story house built circa 1910-1930. The frame structure sits on brick posts and is covered with a low gable roof with 2 interior chimneys. There are two additions on the north and south sides of the house: the north addition is a 1-1/2 story gable roofed space and the south addition is a hipped roof enclosed porch. The windows are two over two sash.

The dwelling is typical of the domestic architecture of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or A.





