The dwelling at 23311 East School Road and located in Deal Island, Somerset County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The dwelling is a late 19th-century, two-story, two-bay frame building with a 20th-century rear wing addition. The building sits upon a low foundation and is covered with a gable roof with cornice returns in the gable ends. A one-story wing covered with a gable roof projects off of the rear elevation of the main house. The house is a common late 19th-century dwelling form found in rural Maryland and lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify it for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and does not qualify for listing under Criteria A or B.

Constructed in 1910, the Harrison House is a two story frame building which is capped by a gable roof and rests on a concrete foundation. The main block of the house measures three bays wide and one bay deep. A one-story addition projects from the main block creating the T-shaped configuration. The site includes several modern metal sheds. Located on East Pool Road on Deal Island, the house appears to be a typical, vernacular dwelling representative of the Island's housing stock of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. There is additional residential development surrounding the Harrison property which appears to be a mixture of historic and modern architecture. The photographs do not illustrate a cohesive historic architectural environment. Based on this limited information, it is my opinion that the building is not individually eligible and that the immediate surrounding environment lacks integrity for a historic district.


