The Holden House, located at 28723 Hudson Corner Road, Marion, Somerset County, MD is not located in a historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Holden House is a 2 1/2 story center gable I-house built in the first quarter of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The frame structure has a porch addition, which is enclosed with jalousie windows. The house appears to be covered with synthetic siding. The windows are one over one sash.

This house is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or A. It lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify it for listing under Criterion C.




