

7: Description:

Located on the west side of Livingston Road, the Van Scoder House is a two-story frame building with asphalt siding. The circa 1910 side-gable house features replacement paired six-over-six sash windows, original two-over-two sash windows, a standing seam metal roof, and a center gable with a diamond-shaped window. There is a two-story rear ell. The front porch is enclosed and there is a one-story side ell. Outbuildings include a circa 1910 frame, pyramidal roofed shed with weatherboard siding, exposed rafter tails, and an asphalt shingle roof. There is also a small frame, front-gable shed with weatherboard siding and an asphalt shingle roof. The house was not accessible.


#8: Statement of Significance:


