Circa 1925

Elgin's Store is one of Cobb Island's earliest structures and the Island's earliest example of commercial architecture. In 1925 Charles Elgin and his wife Lottie built a cottage on Oakley Avenue and in the following year constructed a small store to the north. The storehouse was operated by the Elgin family for 15-20 years and housed the Island's first post office. Marked by its simplicity, the structure is rectangular in form with a shallow pitched roof and exposed rafters. Local accounts associate this store with the sale of bootleg whiskey and local moonshine during Prohibition.

Prepare both a one paragraph summary and a comprehensive description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

Elgin's Store, erected around 1925, is a one-story, front gable structure with an enclosed hipped roof porch. The original frame structure stands at the corner of Main Avenue and Oakley Drive near the heart of Cobb Island's earliest settlement. Marked by its simplicity, the structure is rectangular in form with a shallow pitched roof and exposed rafters. A exterior brick chimney is attached to the east eave wall. 2/2 windows are found on the main block.

The store is currently attached to a later frame cottage which in itself was built in at least two stages. Originally, the store was associated with the cottage to the south. This simple, relatively unaltered, three-bay cottage is defined by its overall side-gable orientation broken by a single dormer on the principal facade. The structure includes German siding, 5-panel doors, exposed rafters, and some original 2/2 windows. This was the home occupied by the Elgin family who ran the corner store to the north.

Elgin Store is one of Cobb Island's earliest structures and the Island's earliest surviving example of commercial architecture. In 1925 Charles Elgin and his wife Lottie built a cottage on Oakley Avenue and in the following year constructed a small store to the north which was operated by the Elgin family for 15-20 years. Elgin's store housed the first post office on the Island.

Cobb Island, long regarded as a peninsula rather than an island, was part of the acreage associated with Pine Grove (CH-703) for much of the 19th century. The first home was established in 1889, with the construction of the Vickers House. In 1918, the entire island was purchased by Robert Crain of nearby Mt. Victoria. Quickly, Crain organized the Cobb Island Development Company with F. B. Bannister & Company as agents. By 1922, surveyors had laid out small narrow building lots and intersecting roads under the direction of civil engineer, Edmund P. Russell of Washington. The first bridge to the island, connecting Bridge Drive to Chigger City was completed in 1923. Within a few years over 80 homes had been built, serving a summer population of between 500 and 700 people.

Elgin's Store has been associated with Cobb Island's locally infamous moonshine and bootlegging activity during Prohibition in the 1930's. A local history published in 1989 quotes resident, James Jenkins, Sr. who remembers Elgin's Store as a place where he and his family would produce bottle and sell "home brew". Jenkins also recounts that the store sold other local moonshine as well as bootleg whiskey from Baltimore. (1)


