The Gates House, located at 13909 Black Valley Road, Flintstone Allegany County, MD, is not located in an historic District nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Gates House is a 1-1/2 story frame house built in 1910-1930. The frame house sits upon a parged cement block base and is covered with a low gable roof. The shed roof porch has been enclosed with siding and windows.

The dwelling is typical of the domestic architecture of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and this thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.




