Building E4015, located in the Edgewood Area of Aberdeen Proving Ground is not eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

According to the information provided, Building E4015 was erected in 1941 as a gas station. It is a modest, one-story, one-room structure built of structural clay tile and covered with a gable roof, clad with asphalt shingles. The building was erected as part of the general World War II construction expansion of the Army installation. According to the HABS documentation, Chemical Warfare Service is listed as the architect of the building.

The building lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C and is not known to have any direct associations with persons or events significant to our past, to qualify it for listing under Criterion A or B.
