This former store building is a one story frame structure covered with German siding. Its gable end fronts onto Railroad Street, but is clipped at an oblique angle to accommodate the oddly shaped corner of Maugansville Road and Railroad Street. The building extends to the south four bays in depth. Windows have original two over two pane sash. Doors have three horizontal panels beneath large glass panes. The main entrance in the north gable wall is located within a recess into which are constructed two doors. A partially enclosed display window occupies some of the remaining part of the front wall. The roof is covered with channel drain sheet metal. The windows, German siding, light frame construction and overall form suggest the early 20th century building date.

This commercial building which has been affiliated with the Maugansville Lumber and Elevator Co., established in the 1890s, reflects the conservative nature of business in Maugansville, and the significance of the railroad in the development of the village. This building is clearly oriented to the railroad as was the entire Maugansville Elevator complex.






