Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Centreville is one of the few communities on the Eastern Shore that has retained much of its historic fabric and has not experienced mammoth growth. Construction subsequent to the 1790s founding of the town has retained the scale and character of the earlier structures. About thirty buildings remain from the 1790-1840 time period. Many of the buildings constructed during the late 19th century building boom are Victorian in design with heavy cornice work and bay windows. The town square and courthouse are significant features of the historic district. Besides being the county seat, Centreville served as a market town for the surrounding area.

Based on the documentation in the vertical file, Centreville is eligible for the National Register. More research and survey work needs to be completed in order to set the official boundary.






