The properties located in the neighborhood between Stoney Run, New Ridge, Smith Farm, Old Ridge and Weeping Willow Roads, Hanover, Anne Arundel County, can be described as follows:

The Donieki Residence, located at 1263 Stoney Run Road, Hanover, is a 1-1/2 storey bungalow style house, with a side gable roof, and large 2 bay cross gable dormers in the attic. The upper storey has been covered in siding, while the first floor wall has been covered with decorative concrete block. The windows are 2 over 2, and there appears to be a porch entrance on the main façade. A second outbuilding appears to be a 1 storey concrete block building with siding in the gable portion of the wall.
The Helm Property located at 1225 Stoney Run Road, Hanover, is a 1-1/2 storey house with a slate gable roof. There is an exterior chimney and the building appears to have 3 bays. The upper portion of the gable walls and the 2-bay dormer have been covered in aluminum siding.
The 1-1/2 storey, three bay house located at 1255 Stoney Run Road, Hanover, has a side gable roof and a gable roof dormer and 2 over 2 windows. The exterior has been covered with stucco.
The Gerard-Burdette House, 7188 Ridge Road, Hanover, is a 2-1/2 storey center gable I house with a 2 bay rear addition. Each wing is under a gable roof, and the windows are 2 over 2.
From the photographs, the building located at 7234 Ridge Road, Hanover is a front gable, 1-1/2 storey building which appears to have a shed roof porch.
The Pitzinger House at 7209 Ridge Road, Hanover, is a 1-1/2 storey, 3 bay house on a raised foundation. It has a side gable roof, an exterior chimney and a large picture window.

None of these buildings retains excellent integrity of materials, setting and form which would qualify them for the National Register of Historic Places either as an example of an early suburban development or individually as architectural examples. Therefore, they are not eligible under Criteria A or C for the National Register.
