Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: (Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)

NA687, Coal Bunker & Extension is an underground reinforced concrete structure that was originally constructed in 1918 as part of the basement floor of the Marine Barracks. Coal was used to fire two boilers located in the basement. The original Coal Bunker was approximately 16 feet x 30 feet. It was later expanded (32 feet x 32 feet) in 1928 to provide additional coal storage space for surrounding housing. The Marine Barracks was subsequently demolished in 1985 following construction of NA298, Bachelor Enlisted Quarters nearby. By this time a road had been constructed over the original Coal Bunker, and the Bunker and its extension were being used to store emergency food and medical supplies. The only means of access to this facility is through a manhole.

NA687 does not possess significance, or those qualities of integrity necessary to meet the criteria for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. Location Plan, Roof Plan, and Section are attached.






Location Map
