Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Built in 1927, this small structure spans a tributary of Blackrock Run. This structure carries Falls Road (MD 25), and it is situated about one mile south of Bridge 3020 (BA-2583). Structure No. 03344X0 is a standard concrete slab type, with a single span. The solid parapet rail is incised with simple, rectangular motifs. This design is similar or identical to the State Road Commission's Standard 18' Slab Bridge (this one measures 17'6") issued in 1924. New guardrail has been placed at the approaches. The guardrail is attached to the structure with metal reinforcing bars that penetrate the parapet walls. While this is an important stabilization feature, it also detracts from the historic architectural status of the bridge (see photographs). According to *Small Structures on Maryland's Road, Historic Context Report* (Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade & Douglas, Inc. 1997:Sec.4 Page 10), to be considered for listing, a concrete slab small structure should retain parapets, abutments, and wingwalls as primary character-defining elements of the substructure. Although this structure appears to retain these elements, the west edge of the slab and the base of the west parapet are very deteriorated.


