This building is a brick and cinder block two-story, two-part commercial block. The building is constructed on a concrete wall foundation and has a recessed front entry. There is a fixed display windows in the first story and there are wood double-hung sash (6/6 lights) in the second story. The display window in the western bay has been replaced by wood siding and double-hung sash windows. The first floor is used as a retail store and the second is occupied by apartments, reached by a wood staircase on the western side of the building.

This building appears to have been constructed in ca. 1925-1930. Because of alterations to the original fabric, this building retains little architectural integrity and appears to be not eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.
