Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Hartman Property is a former single family dwelling with multiple additions now converted to several commercial purposes. The building has a side gable roof and the exterior is clad with wood shingles on the upper story and brick on the ground story. The windows include from 6 over 1, 1 over 1, and large display windows. The first addition created a cantilevered second floor on the front of the building and the western portion of the house was extended by one large bay. This portion is attached to a 1930s commercial building constructed of concrete block with a brick front façade which is two bay wide. At the rear of the property is a one bay front gable garage with wood shingle siding and asphalt shingle roof.

The building represents the transformation of Liberty Road from an area of early 20<sup>th</sup> Century single family dwellings to a commercial district. In part, this was caused by the increase in traffic on Liberty Road. The growth of automobile usage throughout the 20<sup>th</sup> Century made homeowners reluctant to inhabit houses on main thoroughfares such as Liberty Road. Rather, the car culture caused the development of linear commercial areas which provided parking lots instead of than lawns.

The Hartman property lacks a unifying architectural theme. In addition, its lack of integrity of materials, workmanship, setting, and location cause it to be not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places under Criteria A, B, or C. No research was done to determine eligibility under Criterion D.


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


# Ellicott City USGS Quad - 1:24,000
