


4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC yes  The Union Square Methodist Church is a late Greek Revival temple located a short block east of Union Square and is one of the more outstanding buildings in the area. Raised on a high basement, the building is temple form and has a tetrastyle Ionic portico. There is a pedimented main entrance doorway which has been Victorianized by the addition of mid to late 19th C. stained glass. Side windows are the same period murky stained glass and have scroll brackets above them. Accepting the few Victorian alterations, the church is a quite good piece of Greek Revival architecture. (Interior is locked on weekdays but appears to be auditorium type, possibly with galleries, and decorated in a late 19th C. style with a brown and yellow color scheme.
